This bulletin technically interprets the announcement on the release of the IT-600 series new models with Sales Bulletin, no. SB-PA-2008002 issued on January 31st.

Due to discontinuation, the following major parts, devices and software will be integrated in the new models.

- Redesigned antenna for the integrated WLAN module
- New RAM and F-ROM chips, Laser Scanner module and IrDA device
- New Service Pack 1.03 to support the functional compatibility between the current models and the new models
- New ROM OS version

1. Model Numbers and OS Versions

• New Model Numbers

The new models replace the current models as soon as stock of the current models will have run out.

• New OS Version no. 5069a

The OS version will be changed from **5069** to **5069a** integrated in each new model for the first shipment.

The new OS includes Service Pack 1.03, and the Flash Disk folder in each new model includes also the same Service Pack. This mutual complementary system secures the functional compatibility in system configured with a mixture of IT-600 models with different OS and service pack.

Note however that the new OS version **5069a** cannot be installed in the current models due to that the RAM, F-ROM, IrDA devices and PCB are different in their specifications from those integrated in the new models. The table below explains the interoperability of the OS version and models. For example, the OS version **5044** runs for all current models but not for the new models.

• Mixture of Different OSs and Service Packs in System

In order to make an application runs in a system configured with a mixture of different OSs (5069a, 5069 and 5044) and Service Packs without having any OS-related problem, follow the procedure below and understand remarks in Table 2.

Make a master terminal using an OS **5069a** terminal and then copy the content in the master (Source terminal) to all other terminals (Destination terminals) irrespective of the OS version by running **Copy Devices**. This automatically installs Service Pack 1.03 in OS **5069** and OS **5044** terminals.

The following reference table shows the operability of "Copy Devices" in a system configured with different OSs and service packs. Note two "**NG**" denotations indicating that these particular combinations in a system must be avoided, otherwise they may result in copy error.
